



The Playwright

Qui Nguyen is a Vietnamese-American Playwright, Screenwriter and Director who co-founded the OBIE award-winning theatre company, Vampire Cowboys. He is well known for his unique style, which includes the use of puppetry, pop culture references, and stage combat. Some of Nguyen's works include Vietgone, Disney's Raya and the Last Dragon, Peg + Cat, and Alice in Slasherland. He's won an Annie award for his work in Raya and the Last Dragon and a Daytime Emmy for his work in Peg + Cat.

What Was 1995 Like?

1995 was...


a period of great change in the US. It was during the time of the rise of the internet and home computers, Bill Clinton was president and the OJ Simpson trial was ongoing. This time period was pre-9/11, but the Oklahoma City bombing happened in April of that year and is the deadliest act of domestic terrorism in US history. In 1995, HIV mortality rates peaked after steadily rising since the 1980s, and AIDS-related complications were the leading cause of death among 25-44 year-olds.





During this year, there was also a transition from second-wave feminism to third-wave feminism. Second-wave feminism was focused on equality for women, being anti-porn, gaining reproductive rights, and combating workplace inequality. In contrast, third-wave feminism focused more on race, transgender rights, reclaiming womanhood, redefining things that were previously dictated by the patriarchy, and was pro-sex. Third-wave feminism also included the Riot-Grrrl movement, an underground feminist punk movement, that addressed taboo issues such as eating disorders and sexual assault, rejected the victimization of women, and demanded agency for women.

DND had been around for a while by 1995 and had developed a large fanbase but was still pretty niche due to it being a roleplaying game, was not inclusive of women and people of colour, having a lot of competitors, and the satanic panic (a moral panic over satanism spreading in the US, DND was affected by this as some people saw it as supporting Satan).
